

Kwassui Japanese Language and Culture Summer Program 2018

Participants: The program is open to female university students who are studying Japanese and/or are interested in Japan and Japanese culture.

Venues: Classes are held on our Higashi Yamate Machi campus. Evening cultural activities will take place in the Nanko-Ryo student residence on our Shinto Machi campus.

Dates: July 4 (Wednesday) to 19 (Thursday)

Program Fee: ¥75,000(JPY)

This includes: The program's Japanese classes and cultural activities (flower arranging, tea ceremony, trying on Japanese yukata)

Accommodation (twin room arrangement in Kwassui's Nanko-Ryo student residence, with two meals Monday to Friday, three meals at weekends)

Transportation to and from Kwassui campuses when using city buses

Pick-up at the airport and return travel from Kwassui to the airport at specific times on designated days

Not included: Airfare to Japan, lunches Monday to Friday

Please note: Program schedule may be subject to change.

The number of participants is a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 40.

Campus rules: Students are required to observe the following rules as a condition of participation in the program.

1. No smoking. All Kwassui campuses have a strict no-smoking policy.
2. No alcohol. Alcohol is not permitted on any Kwassui campus.
3. Curfew. All Nanko-Ryo residents must return by 10pm unless permission is obtained through the International Center in advance.
