

Kwassui Japanese Language and Culture Summer Program 2019

Participants: The program is open to female university students who are studying Japanese and/or are interested in Japan and Japanese culture.

Venue: Higashiyamate-campus of Kwassui Women's University, Nagasaki, Japan

Dates: July 1 (Mon) to July 12 (Fri)

Program Fee: ¥75,000(JPY)

This includes: Tuition for Japanese classes and cultural activities

Accommodation in Nanko-Ryo student residence (twin room, all meals except weekday lunches)

IC bus card for transportation inside the city

Airport transfers by Kwassui staff, to and from specific airports at designated times only

Not included: Airfare to Japan, lunch on weekdays, airport transfers outside designated times

Please note: Program may be subject to change.

The number of participants is a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 40.

Campus rules: Students are required to observe the following rules as a condition of participation in the program.

1. Drinking alcohol and smoking are prohibited on campus.
2. All Nanko-Ryo (dormitory) residents must return by 10 p.m. unless permission is obtained through the International Student Exchange Center in advance.
3. Failure to follow the rules may result in participants being asked to leave before the program ends.
